Answer: Central Perk, then Bloomingdale's, then Ralph Lauren, then the Paris job with Louis Vuitton.

1. Across its original NBC run, how many seasons and exactly how many episodes did Friends produce?

Answer: Friends ran for 10 seasons and produced exactly 236 episodes.

2. What was the original title of the series premiere, and on what date did it first air on

NBC?

Answer: The premiere was titled "The Pilot," and it first aired on September 22, 1994.

3. Place these milestone episodes in original U.S. broadcast order: "The One After the Superbowl, Part 2"; "The One with Ross's Wedding, Part 2"; "The One Hundredth"; "The Last One, Part 2".

Answer: Lisa Kudrow was the first main-cast actor to win a Primetime Emmy for Friends, doing so in 1998.

5. In which Emmy year did Friends win Outstanding Comedy Series, and which broadcast season had just concluded?

Answer: Friends won Outstanding Comedy Series at the 2002 Emmys, after season 8 had concluded.

6. Which episode is generally cited as the most-watched Friends broadcast in the United States?

Answer: "The One After the Superbowl" is generally cited as the most-watched Friends broadcast in the U.S.

9. Which season had the shortest episode order, and what was that exact count?

Answer: Season 10 had the shortest order, with 18 episodes.

10. Put these Monica-and-Chandler milestones in release order: the London hookup; the group discovers the relationship; the proposal; the wedding.

Answer: The order is: the London hookup in "The One with Ross's Wedding, Part 2" (1998) â the group discovers the relationship in "The One Where Everybody Finds Out" (1999) â the proposal in "The One with the Proposal, Part 2" (2000) â the wedding in "The One with Monica and Chandler's Wedding, Part 2" (2001).

11. Which title belongs to the 100th episode of Friends?

Answer: The 100th episode is titled "The One Hundredth."

12. By the final two seasons, what per-episode salary figure had each of the six principal cast members reportedly reached?

Answer: Each of the six principal cast members had reportedly reached \$1 million per episode by the final two seasons.
